- The process of recycling paper instead of making it from new materials generates 74% less air pollution and uses 50% less water.
- Recycled plastic bottles can be made into products such as clothing, carpeting, detergent bottles and lumber for decking.
- For every ton of steel recycled 2,500 pounds of iron ore, 1,400 pounds of coal, and 120 pounds of limestone are conserved.
- Packaging represents about 65% of household waste.
- The automobile is the most recycled consumer product in the world today. It takes about 45 seconds to shred the average automobile into fist sized pieces for recycling.
