- 2. Creating an environment where business can grow,
- 3. Improving communication between civic leaders and business owners,
- 4. Providing information for business service organizations to help tailor their services to the expressed needs of the local business community.

- 1. What do you like MOST about doing business in the area?
- 2. What is the greatest challenge your business faces today?
 - 3. If we were to recruit a new business to town, what would benefit your operations?
 - 4. What can be done to help your business grow?
