Library Board Presentation

Michele Waite and Thomas Sikora with the Mackenzie Library Board presented a request to Council for an increase of \$39,250 over their 2018 grant amount for wage and benefit increases as well as general inflationary increases. Council will consider opportunities to accommodate the request during upcoming budgetary discussions.

Rocky Mountain Riders Presentation

Scott Carlson, President of the Rocky Mountain Riders Snowmobile Club, presented the club's concerns with the current caribou recovery process.

Mackenzie Recreation Centre Christmas Week Closure

The recreation centre will be closed Monday December 24th to Friday December 28th, reopening Saturday December 29th 2018. The swimming pool will remain closed on Saturday December 29th, 2018 and open with reduced hours on Monday December 31, 2018.

Mackenzie Community Parks and Trails Advisory Committee

Council renamed the Mackenzie Community Parks and Trails Advisory Committee to the Outdoor Recreation Advisory Committee and adopted the revised committee Terms of Reference.

Yellowhead Helicopters Ltd. Airport Lease

Council authorized administration to pursue renewal of a three-year lease agreement with Yellowhead Helicopters Ltd.

Zoning Amendment Bylaw Given First Two Readings

Council gave first two readings to Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 1405, 2018. This bylaw clarifies the definitions of breweries, distilleries, wineries and cideries for zoning purposes.
