### **CivicInfo BC Membership Renewal**

Council directed Administration to renew the District's CivicInfo BC membership at a cost of \$271.27 for 2019. CivicInfo BC provides information services such as statistics, job posting services, professional development opportunities and much more to local government employees, elected officials and members of the public.

### **Emergency Operations Centre UBCM Grant Application**

Council approved the application to the UBCM Community Emergency Preparedness Fund for \$25,000 towards Emergency Operations Centre equipment. The District plans to use the funding to purchase a plotter and a smart board to increase the capacity of the Emergency Operations Centre.

### **Community Campsite Development Phase 2 Grant Application**

Council approved the application to the Northern Development Initiative Trust Economic Diversification Infrastructure program for a grant up to \$15,000 for the Mackenzie Community Non-Service Campsites Development Phase 2 project. This funding would be used for the construction of more campsites, a pit toilet and signage installation at the un-serviced campground on Morfee Lake Rd.

### **Cash Grants and Grants-in-Kind for 2019**

Council considered 2019 cash and in-kind grant requests on an individual basis, and directed staff to review the Grants Policy and provide recommendations to Council on policy and process amendments that can be implemented for 2020.

### **Garbage Truck Capital Purchase**

Council approved the bid from Rollins Machinery to provide an Automated Side Loading Garbage Truck for the base price of \$246,900 plus applicable taxes, and approves the purchase of the optional 5-year Engine and Transmission Extended Warranties in the amount of \$3681 plus applicable taxes.
