CART USE



- Use your garbage cart for waste such as kitchen scraps, floor sweepings, etc.
- Ensure the lid is securely closed on collection day or it will not be collected.
- Keep the interior of your cart clean by bagging your garbage.
- During the winter months, please place your cart slightly away from the curb, in line with your driveway, away from snow banks.

DON'TS

Please DO NOT use for yard waste or recyclables.

Please DO NOT remove the cart from your address if you move. Each cart remains the property of the District of Mackenzie and has a serial number associated with each residence.

BILLING & FEES

Garbage fees and billing will not change for 2019, however please stay tuned for updated rates, fees, and possible alternative billing options for your 2020 annual utility bill.

RECYCLING

The District and the RDFFG are working together to reduce waste that is sent to landfills. We are asking each household to do their part by placing accepted recycling in the RDFFG Multi-Material Recycling Bins or delivering to our local partners. COMPOSTING


Looking for another way to utilize those fruit and vegetable kitchen scraps? Why not use them to create nutrious soil for your garden and yard? Together with the RDFFG, the District has composters for sale at a reduced price for any interested residents.

BEAR AWARENESS

Carts with a lid that is not completely closed or are overfull could attract unwanted wildlife. Please ensure your carts lids are closed completely prior to pick-up.

Carts with lids that are not closed will be considered overloaded and will not be collected.





SETTING OUT CARTS FOR COLLECTION


Please ensure your carts are placed at the curb no later than 8:00 am on your regular day of collection.





Place your cart so the arrows on the lid point towards the street. The wheels should touch the curb and the handle will be facing your property.

Place your cart so there is a 1m (3ft) buffer on all sides, and ensure there is 3m (10ft) of clearance above your cart. Do not park vehicles within 1.5m of your cart.



When emptied, please retrieve your carts from the street and return them to a safe spot on your property
