### Request for Support - Mackenzie Forestry Services

Council received a letter from Frank Lennard of Mackenzie Forest Services requesting a letter of support for a proposal to the McLeod Lake Community Forest to reconstruct Kirby's Cabin on behalf of the Mackenzie Nordique's Cross Country Ski Club. Council passed a motion to provide a letter of support.

### Mackenzie Volunteer Appreciation Week

Council passed a motion to proclaim April 14-20, 2024, as Mackenzie Volunteer Appreciation Week.

### Letter of Support Request – Quintette Mine Early Works

Council received a request from Conuma Mining Services Limited to provide a letter of support for an Early Works application to the BC Government. While waiting for approval for their Restart Application to restart operations in Window, Little Windy Pit and Big Windy Pit mines, a successful Early Works application would permit operations that would keep the workforce employed during any delays. Council passed a motion to provide a letter of support.

### Truth and Reconciliation Calls for Action

Council directed staff to bring a report back outlining the progress that has been made in reaching the goal of "Adopt and make progress on the specific Truth and Reconciliation Calls for Action identified for local Government."

# Land Referral – Application for a Section 17 (Indigenous Protected and Conserved Area)

Council directed staff to reach out to the Ministry of Water, Lands, and Resource Stewardship to set up a meeting to provide further information.

## Land Referral – Application for a Section 56/57 Mackenzie Rocky Mountain Riders

Council directed Administration to respond by stating they were in support of the application and had no objections.

#### Mackenzie Alpine Riders - Request to Amend Licence of Occupation

The Mackenzie Alpine Riders submitted a request to amend their Licence of Occupation agreement to update their management plan to include animals other than horses. Council approved the request.

#### Mackenzie Public Library – Funding Increase Request

Representatives from the Mackenzie Public Library made a funding increase request of \$19,728. Council approved the request, and the annual contribution is now \$298,609.



### 64 Centennial – Janitorial Services Contract

Council awarded the 2024-2025 64 Centennial Janitorial Services Contract to Bee-Clean Building Maintenance for \$3,666.19 per month plus GST for year one of the contract and up to \$3,757.85 for year two of the contract.
