a) Temporary Use Permit Renewal - 75 Centennial Drive # - #

THAT Council authorizes Administration to commence the process for a three-year renewal of a Temporary Use Permit for the property legally described as Lot 1, Plan 18541, District Lot 12463, Cariboo District (75 Centennial Drive).

b) <u>2020 Surplus Allocation</u>
