#### 8. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Mayor Atkinson provided the following Mackenzie Airport Project Update:

It has been brought to our attention that there may have been miscommunication regarding the project that is currently taking place at the District of Mackenzie Airport.

The project is not, as previously noted, an upgrade, but new construction of a terminal and District-owned fuel distribution system.

Currently, the airport and fuel services are operated by Trench Aviation Fuels, who hold a private lease with the District for the property.

Trench Aviation Fuels is a private business that provides fuel and visitor services for the other airport leaseholders and visitors to the area.

As the District does not currently have its own infrastructure to provide these services at our runway, we have entered into a service agreement with Trench Aviation Fuels to offer this service to the public.

It has not been feasible to have our own facilities until now.

Thanks to the generous \$913,158 contribution from the Province of BC and the Northern Development Initiative Trust, the District is now capable of constructing its own new terminal building and fuel distribution system to welcome visitors and businesses to the area.

The project is expected to break ground this summer, with a tentative fall completion date.
