Janice Nelson, Publisher of the Macktown Buzzette asked how the Service Agreement from the Chamber is different from last year? Ms. Kaehn advised that the Service Agreement equates to close to their previous year operational grant. The visitor's services agreement will be brought forward in the future.

Mayor Atkinson replied that yes, the changes are retroactive and are due to the negotiation process taking longer than expected.
