# 13. INQUIRES

JD McKenzie from CHMM Radio asked when the public hearing will be held for the smoking bylaw. Mayor Crook said a date hasn't been set yet. Mr. McKenzie also noted that paving of Mill Road is in the Work Plans and asked if any other roads will be paved. Chief Administrative Officer, Dean McKinley advised that the District is applying for grant funding for other projects. Mayor Crook also advised that the District is committed to evaluating the condition of Highway 39 to Gantahaz.

Rick Gauthier asked for clarification on who would enforce the cannabis prohibition. Councillor Atkinson indicated that cannabis should be treated the same as alcohol. Mayor Crook advised that we will determine how to handle this through the public consultation process.

Bonnie Nicol asked if the RCMP will be educating the community on what is legal and illegal regarding cannabis.

Shannon Bezo asked if the Public Hearing that is required for the Zoning Amendment Bylaw could affect the Business Licence Amendment, District Smoke Free Places and Municipal Ticketing Amendment Bylaw that will be adopted at the next Council meeting. Mayor Crook advised that information gathered at the time of the Public Hearing will be taken into consideration.

Janice Nelson from the Macktown Buzzette indicated that the public is disappointed about the reduced hours of operation for the swimming pool. Kevin Clarkson, Director of Recreation Services advised that at this time we are making every effort to ensure we are open to the public when we say we are and that we are currently assessing our programs and services at the pool.

Rick Gauthier asked about donating fire wood to the needy from the waterfall trail. Mayor Crook advised that the trail is already there and we are upgrading the existing trail.

Dave Schindler feels that there should be public consultation with respect to the temporary prohibition of recreational cannabis. Mayor Crook advised that there will be a public hearing with respect to Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 1389 and that once the temporary prohibition is in place the public will have ample opportunity to have their views heard.
