### 13. INQUIRIES

JD McKenzie from CHMM Radio asked if the Mackenzie Investment Readiness Initiative will address housing issues. Chief Administrative Officer (CAO), Dean McKinley advised that this project does not directly address this, but we will be looking at a Housing Needs Assessment in 2019.

Mr. McKenzie also asked what the cost recovery target is for recreation services. The Director of Recreation Services, Stacey Miranda, advised that the District has a mandate of remaining one of the lowest admission rates in the comparison market.

Janice Nelson from the Macktown Buzzette asked if the evacuation route planning was part of what Blackwell did. Mayor Atkinson advised that Blackwell did the fuel management prescriptions for the Community Wildfire Protection Plan (CWPP). This application is for evacuation route improvement planning.

Ms. Nelson also asked when Carscadden did the last update to Council. CAO Dean McKinley advised that Carscadden has not been asked to provide an update on the recreation project since the summer update.

Kevin McIntyre asked if user groups will no longer receive revenues from the advertising program at District-owned or operated facilities. Stacey Miranda, Director of Recreation Services, advised that moving forward we can now work together with user groups.
