Land Referral - Notice of Work Terus

The Sonic Pit is a 38.04-hectare sand and gravel operation near Mackenzie, BC, owned by Terus Construction. The notice of work (NoW) application is for an amendment to Mines Act Permit G-9-65 to operate and expand the existing footprint of their operation within their tenured area as well as an amendment application to extend the operational dates of the pit. Council voted that the District of Mackenzie has no objections to the approval of the application, provided that the review period does not exceed 15 years or any other timeframe deemed acceptable by the Inspector of Mines – Permitting, Northeast/North Central Region office.

FireSmart Structure Protection Trailer

Council awarded the contract for the purchase of the Structure Protection Unit Trailer to Kitt Equipment for a total of \$29,105.11 plus GST.
